




#### **PARTICIPANT DEMOGRAPHICS**

This one-day leadership clinic brought together a diverse group of middle school students to practice basketball, soccer and lacrosse while exploring key social and emotional leadership skills. 

#### SPORTS CHALLENGE

Sports Challenge, Strive's foundational program, returned again in 2024 as a 5-day summer leadership academy welcoming basketball and soccer athletes to the highly demanding yet nurturing program.

This year we maintained a 1:5 coach-athlete ratio providing participants individualized mentorship as they discovered the character-driven leader within.





# STAFF & COACH IN TRAINING PROGRAMS



Coach and Staff Training has been a flagship program of Strive's work since launching our first National Coaches Leadership Institute in 2011. This training has a unique focus on culture building, providing experiential learning opportunities for coaches to develop team cultures that foster leadership at every level. Our Coaches in Training program was launched as an exciting new opportunity for high schoolers to attend Strive **Coaches Trainings** alongside Strive Coaches and gain experience coaching younger student-athletes at Strive's Middle School Clinic and/or Sports Challenge. Our inaugural cohorts of participants demonstrated the true potential of the voung leaders we work with and we are excited to continue this program in 2025.



#### **DELAWARE PROGRAMMING**

In 2024, Strive deepened our Delaware connections through year-round partnerships that brought our leadership programming to local schools and community hubs.

#### **Nativity Prep**

We've been working with their 7th and 8th grade boys weekly, implementing the Middle School Curriculum along with monthly House challenges for the entire school.

#### **Sanford School**

Sanford School has demonstrated the impact of sustained partnership, hosting Sports Challenge for two years running and now adding our upcoming Middle School Clinic. In addition, Sanford welcomed workshops focused on leadership and personal growth for their 9th-grade class and JV and Varsity Boys Basketball teams, championing our shared commitment to developing young leaders.









#### NATIONAL PROGRAMMING

In 2024, Strive strengthened our national partnerships, bringing impactful leadership experiences to youth and student-athletes across the country. These partnerships have been essential in spreading Strive's mission of accessible and transformative leadership across diverse communities.

#### SafeHub

Our collaboration brought SafeHub's PlayMakers and other student-athletes to our Middle School Clinic and Sports Challenge, where they engaged in coach development and mentorship training.

#### Harlem Lacrosse - Philadelphia

We partnered with Harlem Lax, hosting a summer workshop with the Olney Elementary Boys Lacrosse team focused on positive energy—a partnership we look forward to expanding into year-round programming for middle schoolers.

#### **Collegiate Athletic Conferences**

Strive facilitated leadership workshops with student-athletes in the Atlantic East Conference and Old Dominion Athletic Conference.
